CAR PARKING AT CABOOLTURE HOSPITAL October 2019

Over the next 4 years, Caboolture Hospital will undergo a significant expansion and redevelopment. The project will deliver a new 5 level Clinical Services Building, a multi-storey car park and will refurbish existing spaces.



The new building and car park will be built at the front of the hospital, between the current buildings and McKean Street.

How will this project impact parking?

The Caboolture Hospital Redevelopment Project and the multi-storey car park will take over nearly all the car parking at the front of the hospital site, including the helipad.

Alternative car parking is needed to ensure there is enough parking for staff, patients and visitors during construction.

Frequently Asked Questions

Staff car parking

Where will the temporary car park be?

The temporary car park will be built on the Caboolture State High School land adjoining Mewett Street.

This car park is intended to be for staff use only.

When will the temporary car park be open?

The temporary car park is expected to start construction in late 2019 and be open in early 2020.

Will we have to pay to park in the temporary car park?

No.

How long will the temporary car park be used?

The temporary car park will be used until the new multi-storey car park opens. The timeframe for the multi-storey car park is still being finalised but will be delivered in a coordinated manner with the broader hospital redevelopment.

Will the temporary car park be secure?

The design for the car park is currently underway. Security is a paramount design principle, will include lighting, fencing, CCTV, duress and call points and access restrictions.

Will any assistance be offered to help people with mobility issues?

The temporary car park will be designed as a fully accessible car park. Staff with mobility issues will be supported.

Patient and visitor parking

What will happen to other car parks on site?

The large staff car park between the loading dock and Caboolture State High School will become a patient/visitor car park. All other car parks are expected to continue to operate as they do currently during the construction period.

Access to the hospital

The temporary car park is at the “back” of the site. What is the plan for people arriving at the hospital?

The front of the site is also expected to be a busy construction zone. It will be important to minimise vehicle movements in this area to avoid interruptions to construction and to ensure safety for all visitors to the hospital site. Hospital staff will be encouraged to enter the site via access off Mewett Street and park in the new temporary car park.

A new temporary main entry will be created. While the design is still being finalised, this will include a temporary welcome area, signage and wayfinding, changes to the internal road network and a review of pathways. It is anticipated that visitors will be able to access the Temporary Main Entrance (temporary arrival area) and car park from Mewett Street and Bury Street.

The temporary main entry is expected to open in early 2020.

How will people access the Emergency Department?

Access to the Emergency Department will be maintained at the front of the hospital. A drop-off zone and small number of car spaces will be available.

How will staff get to Central Lakes Shopping Village?

Access to McKean Street, and to the shopping centre, will be maintained during the construction phase.
