What is LSVT LOUD? ®

The Lee Silverman Voice Treatment (LSVT LOUD®) program is currently the most efficacious treatment for the speech disorder in Parkinson's Disease.

This speech disorder, known as hypokinetic dysarthria, is characterised by soft, slurred and monotonous speech. This speech disorder impacts significantly on the person's quality of life through the loss of social connection with family and friends due to their reduced ability to communicate.

ENT Referral

LSVT LOUD® is an intensive voice program. All patients require a laryngeal examination by an ENT specialist for clearance to participate prior to commencing the treatment.

When referring your patients to LSVTLOUD®, your assistance in referring your patients to an ENT Specialist is required.

Pre-LSVT LOUD® evaluation

Sixteen x one hour therapy sessions delivered as four sessions per week over four consecutive weeks.

Post - LSVT LOUD® evaluation.

Daily home exercise program
